Mothers with a heart for Ethiopia formed in 2011 with 3 adoptive mothers from Southwestern Ontario. Two different geographical regions were soon established. Mothers with a heart for Ethiopia, Guelph group has been managed by Nancy Gibbs Keithlin and Paula Rogers on 100% Volunteer Efforts. Our goal is to support, partner with, and empower women and children in Ethiopia. We have financially and morally supported Kingdom Vision International Orphanage, aging out females, provided business grants to Ethiopian women, partnered with the Women's Former Firewood Carriers group, Korah Women's necklace business, nurtured local partnerships with the Ethiopian community, and organized over 30 formal fundraising events. Over the last decade, we have supported Ethiopian children in education, seniors, single mothers and a widower with infant triplets. During Covid, we upheld our financial commitments to local immigrants as well as sustained educational funding for the Ethiopian beneficiaries most in need.
