Mothers with a heart for Ethiopia was founded in 2011 by three Ethiopian adoptive mothers from Southwestern Ontario. Two different geographical regions were soon established. Mothers with a heart for Ethiopia, Guelph group have been led by Nancy Gibbs Keithlin and Paula Rogers on 100% Volunteer Efforts. Our goal was to financially support and empower Women and Children, in Ethiopia. We have financially and morally supported Kingdom Vision International Orphanage, aging out females, provided business grants to Ethiopian women, partnered with the Women's former firewood Carriers group in Addis, Koran women's necklace business, nurtured local partnerships with the Ethiopian community, organized over 30 formal fundraising events, supported Ethiopian children in education, seniors, single mothers and a widower with triplets. During Corvid, we upheld our financial commitments to local immigrants as well sustained educational funding for the Ethiopian beneficiaries most in need. In 2021, we formally joined partnership with E4Change. Nancy Gibbs - Keithlin and Paula Rogers are currently members of the Board of Directors.
